Description:

The Westin at Queretaro is iconic development perched high upon a hill overlooking the historic Spanish city of Santiago de Queretaro. An ancient lake bed creates a unique geography which designers have leveraged with what will be the tallest building in the City, taking full advantage of the spectacular view corridors.

The mixed-use 42-story structure is anchored into the bedrock of the steeply sloping site. There are multiple uses on each floor with parking below grade. A 120-key Westin hotel anchors the development that includes office, condominiums, and rooftop helipad. Amenities include a 1,000-seat meeting hall, 6-room conference center, 4 boutique restaurants, spa and an infinity pool.
